Gods, goddesses, heroes and myths. That's the core of **Classical Civilisations**. This subject explores Ancient Greek and Roman views on myths, religion, politics and philosophy. We chart the role and actions of our heroes in the Trojan War and how they escape from it to build the ancient city of Rome. We analyse Greek contextual views about kingship and the dangers of autocracy, whilst evaluating the benefits of democracy and it's role in Greek society through tragic play and comedy. And we finally explore the ancient Greek cults and religious practice through sanctuaries, games and festivals. Rounding this off with deep philosophical thinking through the likes of Socrates and Plato. Be a part of something different.

The **History** course at Clarendon explores content that you may not have studied before. Popularised on recent TV shows such The Last Kingdom and Vikings, we here at Clarendon explore the Vikings in depth.

Was it all just pillaging, raiding and murder?

Well, you'll have to join us to find out! We also cover some of medieval age England. The ever famous Wars of the Roses, where the two counties of Lancashire and Yorkshire fought bloody battle after battle to reign supreme. Finally, we explore the more familiar topic of Germany after the fallout of The Great War, leading up to the fall of the Berlin Wall.
