**A level Geography is a two year course and the examination board is AQA.**

**At the end of the course there are two examinations:-**

**Paper 1 = Physical Geography- this includes topics such as Water, Carbon and Coasts**

**Paper 2 = Human Geography- This includes topics such as Urban Issues and Global Governance.**

**The third element is a piece of coursework or project called an NEA (Non Examined Assessment). This can be on any suitable topic covered by the specification.**

**We aim to complete at least three field work visits when we learn how to collect data. The visits can be local or further afield. Under normal circumstances we would also offer a trip abroad to somewhere such as Italy or USA**
